Our **purpose** is to *empower those impacted by trauma by providing a safe place to receive comprehensive services through a coordinated team approach from dedicated trauma-informed professionals.*

Our work has not changed: advocacy, forensic interviewing, medical, counseling, and education will continue to be at the center of our work for both children, their families, and women in our residential program. We look forward to expanding our restorative care to enhance the lives for women and children living on-site.
