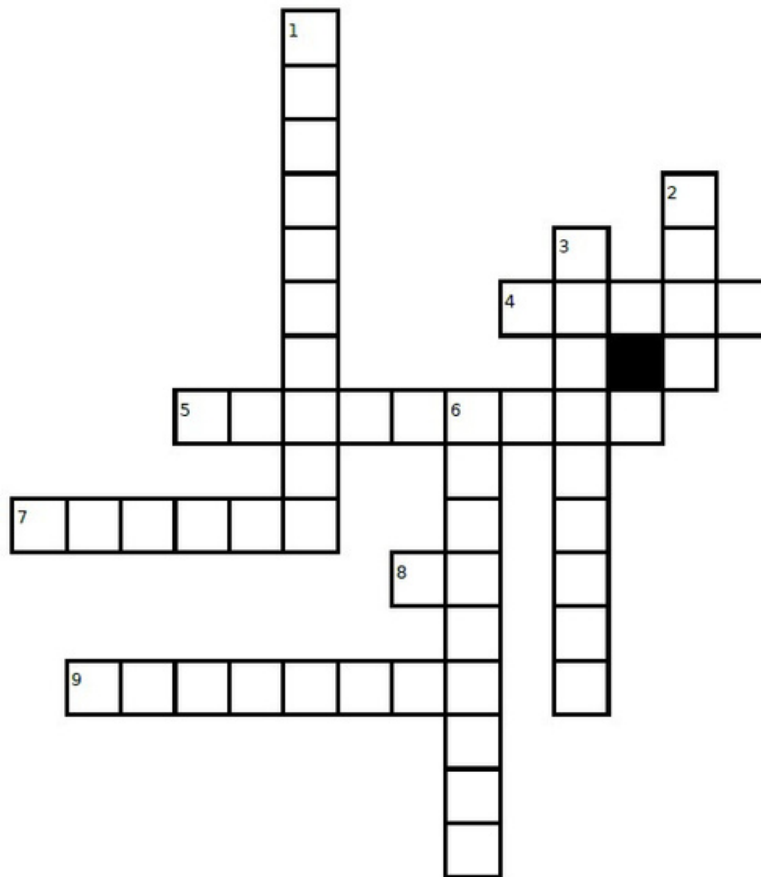


MAKING SMART CHOICES
